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Foreword

This Guideline has been elaborated by the "Training for Qualified Persons" project group of the Technical Committee on "Plant Engineering". It serves as a basis for the qualification of qualified persons involved in gas measurement and pressure reduction stations.

DVGW Standards G 280-1, G 459-2, G 491, G 492, G 495, G 498 and G 499 stipulate that any type of work on gas measurement and pressure reduction stations requiring qualification shall be exclusively performed by qualified personnel.

Clause 3.1 of this Guideline lists the general requirements for qualified persons accordance with DVGW Standards G 459-2, G 491, G 492 and G 495. Qualified persons consequently will have to attend seminars and hands-on training courses and acquire field experience to develop the necessary expertise.

This DVGW Guideline offers guidance on the scope of the required qualification of personnel and the contents of the training curriculum.
